Sonia Livingstone is Professor of Social Psychology and Head of the Department of Media and Communications at the London School of Economics and Political Science. Her research examines children, young people and the internet; social and family contexts and uses of ICT; media and digital literacies; the mediated public sphere; audience reception for diverse television genres; internet use and policy; public understanding of communications regulation; and research methods in media and communications. Sonia Livingstone directs a 25-country network, EU Kids Online, for the EC's Safer Internet Programme. She serves on the Executive Board of the UK's Council for Child Internet Safety, and has served on the Department of Education's Ministerial Taskforce for Home Access to Technology for Children, and Ofcom's Media Literacy Research Forum. Since 2007, she is an elected fellow of the Danish Royal Society of Sciences and Letters.
